

My first day

Where do I go when I arrive?

Parents and students all arrive to the main Assembly area on the first day of term. There are no other students in the school on your first day. YOU have the school to yourselves -other than the teachers!

Your parents can have a cup of tea while you can take a seat in the assembly area or chat to your friends.

What happens then?

The Principal speaks to your parents and then they go home. The Principal, Deputy Principal and your Year Head will speak to you. You are then sent off to your classes with your class Tutor until break time.

What do we do in class?

Your tutor will go through the timetable and the school map and explain how the day will work. YOU will receive the rest of your books that you may not have received on the day of the Book Rental, your locker and your school journal.

Do we get a break?

At break time the canteen is open and you have your break. After break you follow your timetable. Your Tutor will have shown you where to go to.

What do we do at lunch time?

At lunchtime the canteen is open. You remain in the school for lunchtime every day. You can take in lunch or purchase your lunch in the canteen. You sit in the Assembly area and have your lunch.

After Lunch what happens?

You continue to follow your timetable and go to the classes.

Where do I go if I need something?

Your class Tutor and Year Head will be there to help you. The Guidance Counsellors, Ms Faherty and Ms Mc Morrow are also available to help you. At any stage you can ask any teacher or an SNA if you need help. You can also go to the main office.
